PENTECOST: ACTS 2

Pentecost was a very important moment for the beginning of the Church, and it's an important moment in our church, too. It's about preparation for what is to come, to receive the energy and power we need, through the Spirit, to carry out God's work here on Earth.

God ordained this time to send His Spirit. Just as the Jewish Passover became Easter because of Jesus' sacrifice, the Jewish Festival of Weeks (a time of sacrifice to grow closer to God) became Pentecost because of the gift of the Spirit.

Living by the law means trying to be right with God through hard work. Living by the Spirit means being fully alive. The gifts of the Spirit display God's power, and the fruit of the Spirit reveal the characteristics of a holy life. We must be refilled everyday, as leaky vessels, with more and more of God's Spirit.
