The Paradox of Discipleship: A Journey Towards Easter.

As we journey towards Easter, the call of Jesus to "deny yourself, take up your cross, and follow me" resonates with a profound challenge. This directive, steeped in the imagery of sacrifice and surrender, might initially strike us as a path laden with loss. 
